

# Scavenger Hunt from A to Z

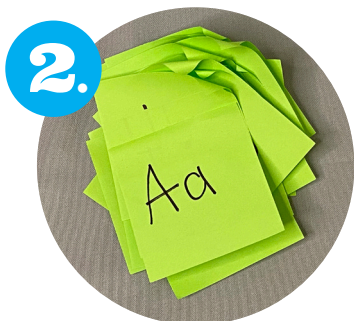

Do you want to go on adventure, but you're stuck inside? The best way to go anywhere is to read a book. Before you start this activity check out a book from your local library about a harebrained quest like *What Pete Ate from A-Z* by Maira Kalman. After reading, go on a scavenger hunt in your home and see how many things you can find that start with each letter of the alphabet.



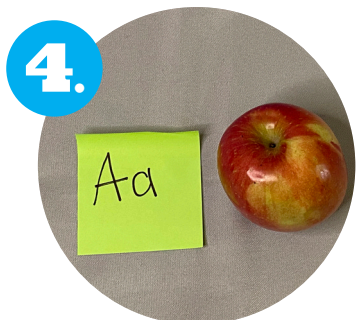
1. Decide whether you wish to work together as a group or create teams.



2. With a marker write each letter of the alphabet in upper and lowercase on post-it notes or scrap paper. Example: Aa, Bb, Cc and so on. Put all letters in a circle or pile.



3. Each player picks a letter randomly and finds an object in the house that starts with that letter. Ready, set, GO!



4. Every item with the correct letter wins a point. The player with the most points wins.



5. As you wrap up the game, review each object by saying the letter and the name out loud together, example "A is for Apple" or "Apple starts with A".



6. Remember to be sure to put everything back where you found it after the game is over.
